The Making of the New Testament Canon: The Authority of the Early Church. The need to have written authorities for what to believe and how to live drove Christians to construct a *canon* of Scripture. Having already accepted the Jewish Scriptures (The Christian Old Testament) as an authoritative account of God's word, the need for additional, distinctively Christian authorities standing on equal footing with the Old Testament writings arose. This session will focus on how early Christian leaders debated which books of the apostles to include in the "New" Testament. Discussion will be led by Gene Pickler.
