

We currently are not cooking/serving the evening meal at the Coalition one Friday a month due to the pandemic. However, we are sending them a donation of \$340 (what we normally spend on the food) and \$120 (what we normally spend to make up small bags of toiletries for the community people who stop by to get dinner). Every December members of our congregation donate new, white socks to be distributed to the men at the Coalition for the Homeless. This pandemic year was no exception but it was different. We still asked our members/friends to donate the white socks. At the end of December the Hannah Circle members folded/rolled the socks and inserted a small card with scripture printed on it—one side in English, the other in Spanish. On January 8th seven Hannah Sisters met to roll the socks and insert the Scripture cards. We will distribute the 394 pairs of socks around January 15th.

One of our Hannah Sisters, Kathy Anderson, was unable to turn her socks in before the collection deadline. She rolled the ones she bought and decided to just donate them to needy people. That Friday evening she and her husband, Charlie, were on their way to shop and saw a man who appeared to be homeless, wearing sandals with no socks and waiting at a bus stop. She asked him if he would like a new pair of white socks. He said he would so she gave him a pair.

Kindness matters, no matter the circumstances. "As you have done for the least of these, you have done for Me."
