PRESBYTERY CUBAN CHURCH PARTNERSHIP – URGENT NEED FOR OTC MEDICINES

John Gehrig and Matt Straub will not be traveling to Central Cuba with the CF Presbytery Cuban Network this February. The situation there remains too fluid, and our presence could place additional food and transportation burdens on our hosts. We hope to visit in October if conditions stabilize. At this time, the most urgent need is for **over-the-counter (OTC) medicines**, which our Presbytery reports are *non-existent* and *desperately needed* in Central Cuba. Requested items include pain relievers, antibiotic creams, allergy medicines, anti-diarrheal medicine, band-aids, and vitamins (larger containers welcome), as well as small craft supplies. 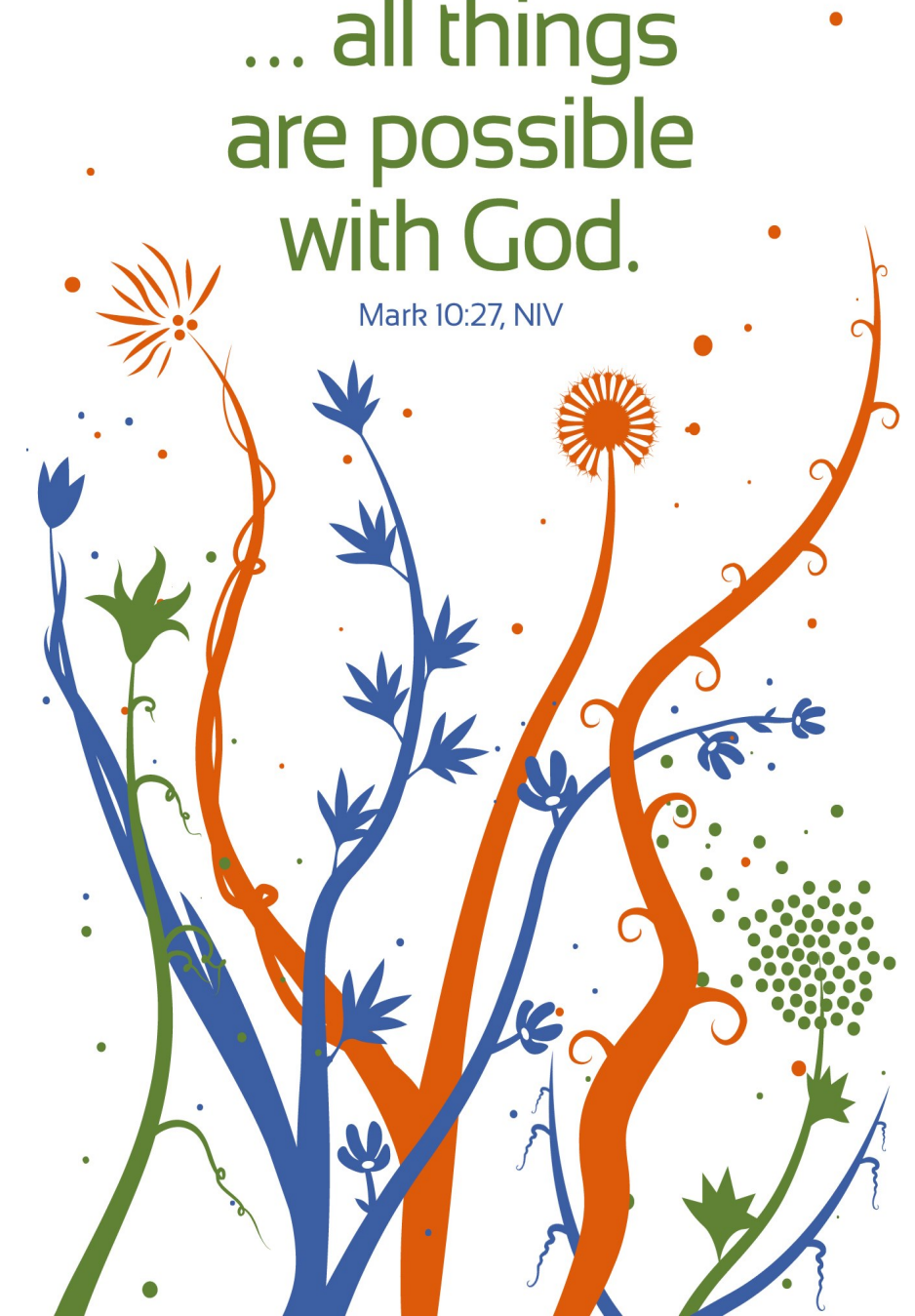
