

\* THE REAFFIRMATION OF FAITH • The Nicene Creed

Twelve percent covers administrative costs. When we serve at the Coalition on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of each month, we normally take 3 grocery bags of magazines, books, calendars, and puzzles that members of our WPPC congregation have donated. On January 14th, we had only 1 bag of reading materials to offer our Coalition guests. Adding to the problem, we served over 100 more folks than we have recently served. Onset of the Covid virus has greatly affected our volunteering at the Coalition; we now serve 3 separate groups—women/children (living on site), "residents" (males living at the Coalition), and "community" (those coming from outside the Coalition to receive a meal). Therefore, the Compassion Committee requests appropriate reading materials for 3 groups: men, women, and children. We thank you for your generosity!
