October 31st - The Holy Land Revealed—Lecture 10: The Hellenization of Palestine

With this session, we resume our study of the ancient history of what many people know as the Holy Land, a geographical area that includes modern Israel, Jordan and the Palestinian territories. Having previously looked broadly at the spread of Greek culture in the ancient Near East, this lecture will focus on the impact of Hellenization on the non-Jewish peoples in ancient Palestine. Attention will be given to the principle of town planning that adhered to the Hippodamian gridiron concept with zones designated for specific purposes. Gene Pickler will lead the discussion.
