COALITION DONATIONS NEEDED

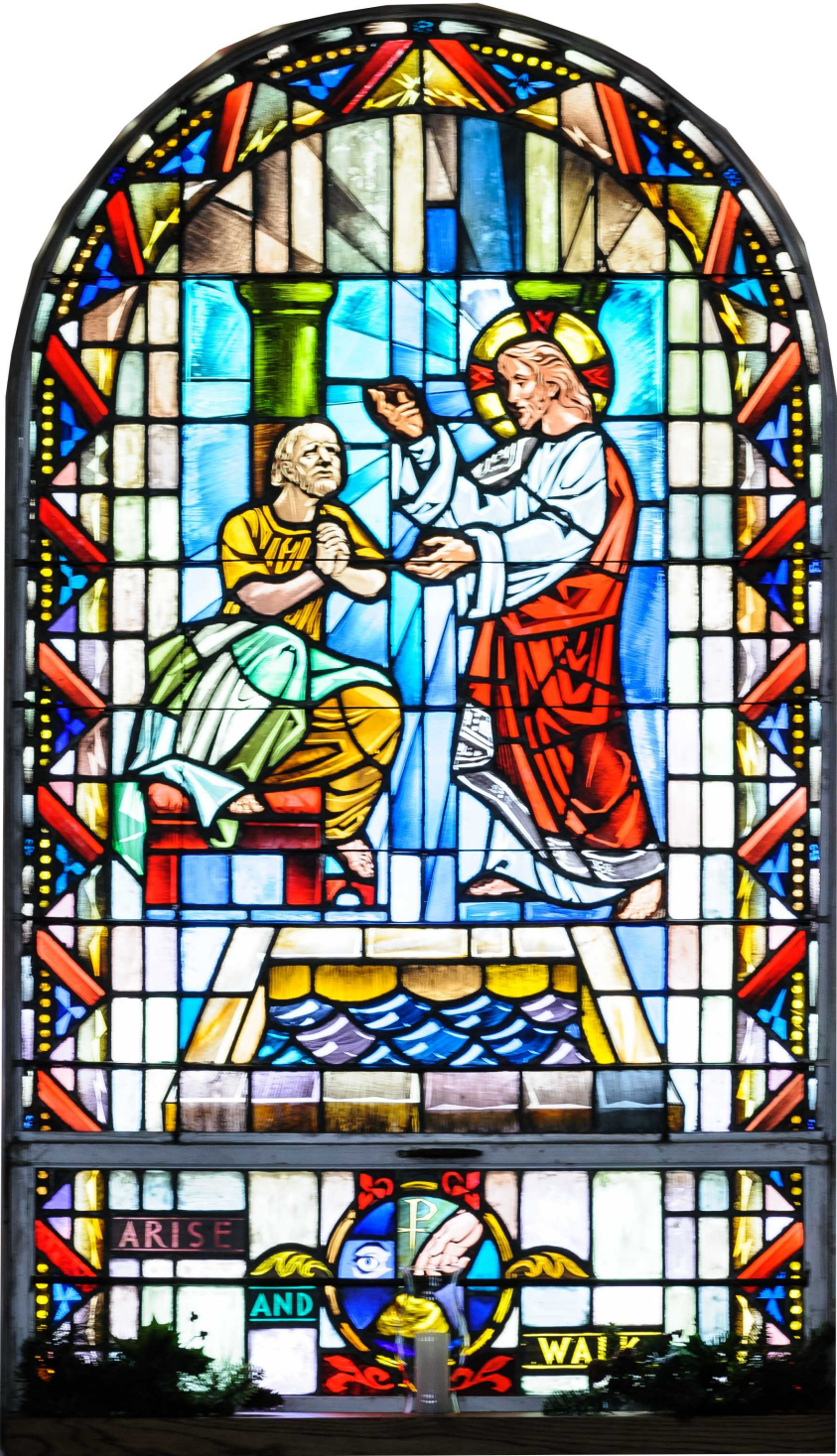
