The Relationships in Action Sunday School class continues their "Spiritual Conversations" series with a visit from long-time WPPC member Sue Rudolph.

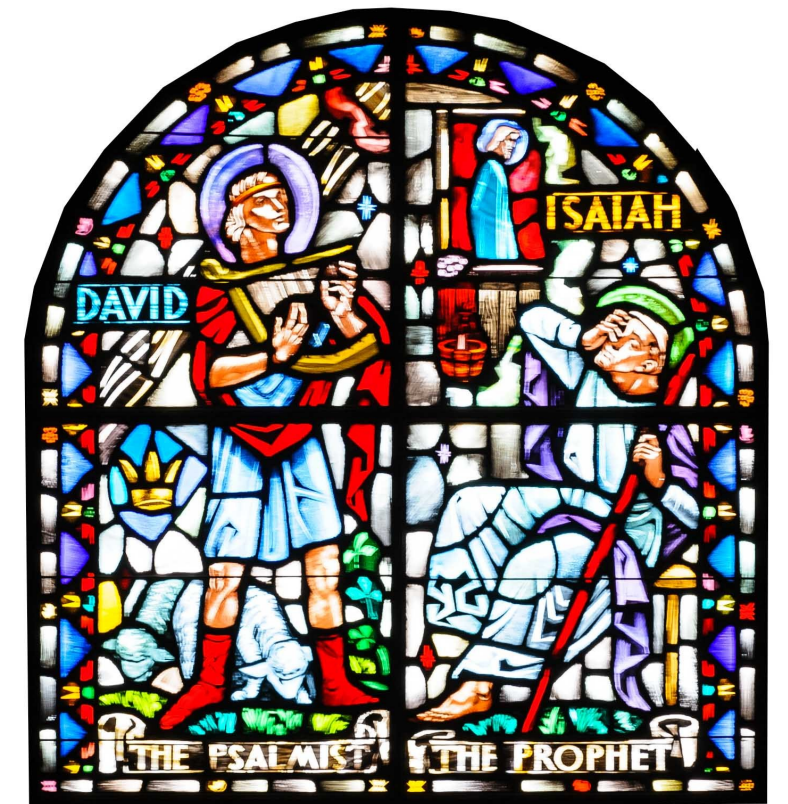
