5 Cents A Meal Offering Next Week

Next Sunday, April 25, we will take the second quarterly collection for 5 Cents A Meal this year. Please continue your support for PATH (Presbyterian's Answer To Hunger). The offering is sent to Presbytery, which divides the monies among Second Harvest Food Bank (25%), Society of St. Andrew (SOSA) (gleaning local fields - 21%), Alliance for International Reforestation (AIR) in Guatemala (planting fruit trees and installing fuel-efficient brick stoves in remote poverty-stricken villages - 21%), and Dan and Elizabeth Turk PC (USA) mission workers in Madagascar (training seminary students in planting/cultivating fruit trees, and helping Elizabeth implement a community health program, teaching AIDS awareness and advising the family planning program - 21%). Twelve percent covers administrative cost.
