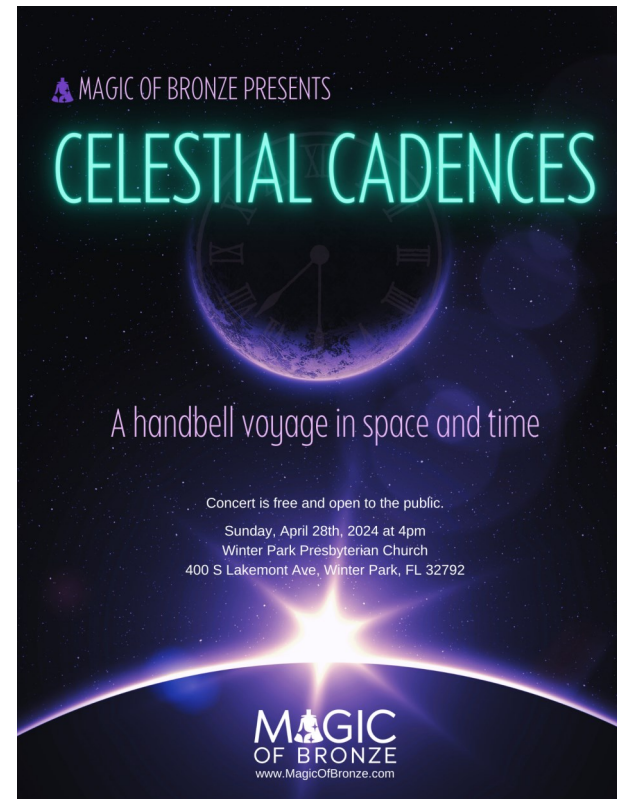
FLOWERS
