**Electronic Giving Option**

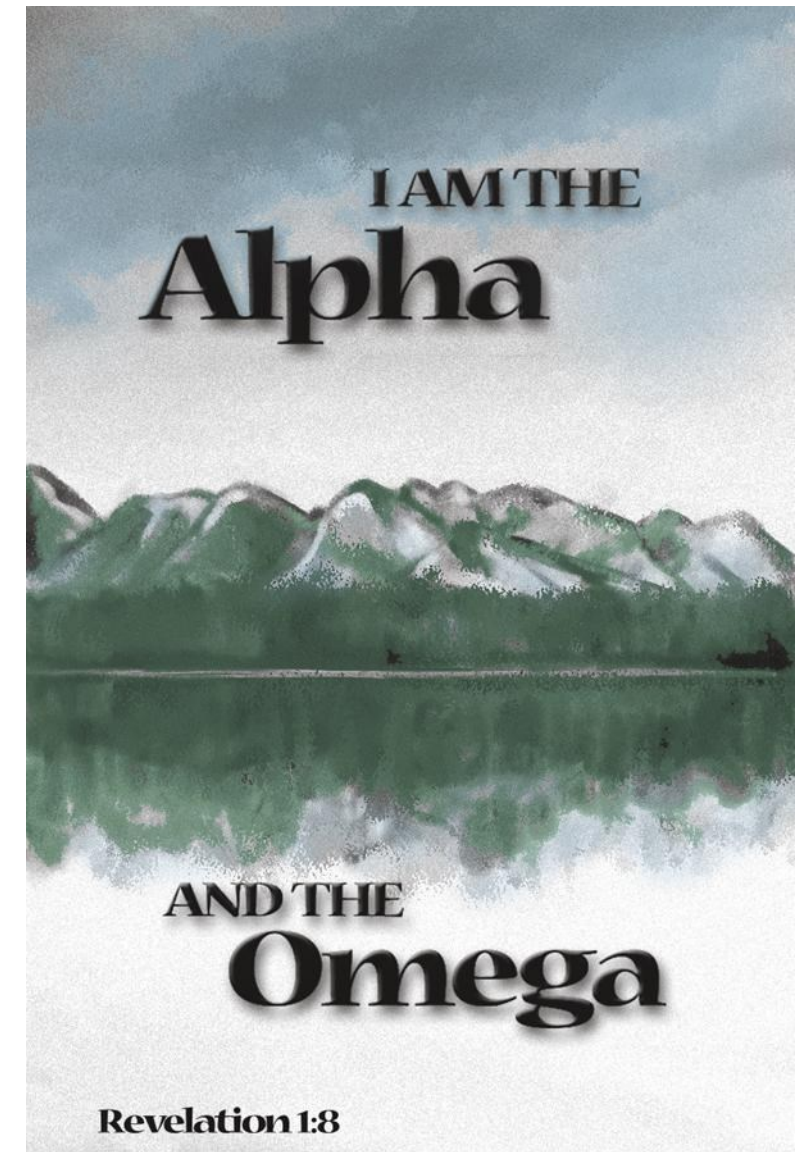
