Audrey Santiago is the director of Transitions Orphan Assistance Foundation, Inc. She was born and raised in southeast Pennsylvania but has been an Oviedo, FL resident for 35 years. She is a long-time member of the Winter Park Presbyterian Church. Since 2008, Audrey has made orphan assistance her passion. She lived in Odesa, Ukraine for almost eight years, volunteering first in Orphanage #4, and later working with older orphans who have aged-out of the orphanage and have no one to advise them and nowhere to go. Audrey helped to establish and maintain transitional/foster homes for older orphans. In addition, she has helped to build rent-to-own homes for young adult orphans to live in after they graduate from trade school. TOAF also supports orphans in the Pishana Orphanage and vulnerable families in villages surrounding Pishana. Audrey’s home base is now in Oviedo, but she shares her time between the US and Ukraine. The mission of Transitions Orphan Assistance Foundation continues to evolve and expand to accommodate the needs of those we serve.
