BACK TO SCHOOL SUPPLIES

For many years, we have supported Aloma and Killarney Elementary Schools in their efforts to properly supply their students for a successful school year.

- This year Killarney still requests girls and boys underwear, but needs to refill sizes 4T—8, which are the sizes used most. They also need <u>ankle</u> socks in sizes kids large and adult.
- Aloma requests "over ear wired headphones with mic" as every student uses a computer and headphone every day. Many parents cannot afford to purchase or replace headphones. The headphones Aloma prefers are from 5 Below Discount Store and cost \$5.55 each. If members of WPPC are unable to pick headphones up at 5 Below, Compassion Committee is providing a table in the narthex after the 10:30am service from 6/30-8/4 to accept donations toward headphones which Compassion will purchase and deliver.

Please join Compassion Committee in supporting these two schools with their "Back to School" needs. Collection for underwear, socks, and headphones will be from 6/30-8/4 with red bins in the office hallway and narthex.

BACK TO SCHOOL UPDATE:

In the three weeks the Compassion Committee has been collecting items for Aloma and Killarney Elementaries, we have received donations of \$485 for the purchase of headsets and 11 actual headsets; this will provide 98 headsets to Aloma Elementary thus far. In addition, the WPPC congregation has donated 51 packages of underwear and sox for the children at Killarney Elementary. What a generous congregation we have that values the importance of helping to prepare students for a successful school year.
