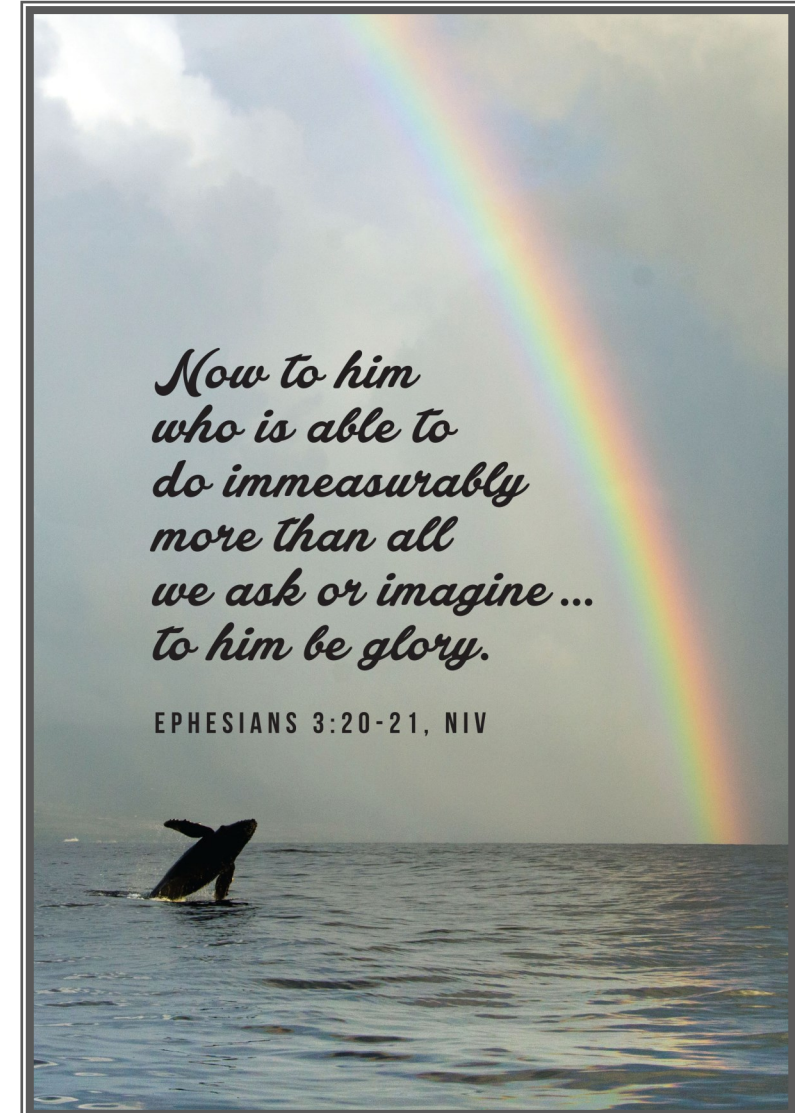

Welcome Rev. Walk Jones

We welcome Rev. Walk Jones to the pulpit today. Rev. Jones is Director of Church Relations for Westminster Communities of Florida, the church-related nonprofit that manages Westminster Winter Park and 20 other retirement communities across the state. He served as pastor of St. Andrews Presbyterian Church in Apopka back in the 1990s as well as two other congregations. Most recently he was chaplain at Westminster Towers Orlando. He and his wife, Nancy, have three children and now a granddaughter.

Update on the Interim Pastor Search

On June 25th, the same evening the WPPC Session accepted Rev. Micheli’s resignation as our senior pastor, we immediately voted to begin the work of searching for an interim senior pastor to lead our church until a full-time replacement could be brought on board. An ad hoc Interim Pastor Search Committee was formed with the following representatives from the church’s various functional areas:

These committee members have been meeting every Sunday to review the names of ministers who are both interested in and have the qualifications to serve as our interim pastor. To date, we have received nearly a dozen names, and we have been reaching out to those individuals to gauge their interest in the position and to request more information about their experience, beliefs, and capabilities. Serving as an interim senior pastor is a specialized calling that requires many special skills. One thing has become clear—there are many excellent candidates from which to choose.

The committee is eager to move quickly through the vetting process, with the goal of hiring an interim pastor by the end of the summer. We request the congregation’s patience and prayers as we try to identify the best fit for this very important position.
