EMERGENCY PROCEDURES In light of the recent events in Nashville and other areas needed. In the fall of 2022 we upgraded our Security System as well as our policies and procedures. Our top priority is to keep your children healthy and safe while in our care. Ten new security cameras have been installed in all outside areas of the preschool. We are able to monitor the school from two different offices. Security codes have also been updated to enter the gate, and only preschool staff members have the code. Our staff are equipped with walkie-talkies to contact the office and others in case of an emergency. We now have in place a Code system similar to the public schools. We are working closely with the WP Police Dept. and area schools in the event of an emergency in the area.
