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CAR CIRCLE UPDATE

On Monday, August 19 all of our 3s and VPK will be using car circle in the morning and afternoon. As we transition to full car circle use, we have had staff stationed around the parking lot and car circle observing opportunities to make improvements and helping to remind parents to:

- 1. Use the crosswalk closest to Dundee when walking to and from classrooms. Do not cross at the Pine Playground crosswalk or walk through the Noah's Ark tunnel as we are using it to move 3s to and from their cars (exception: VPK parents and students moving to and from the pine playground.)
- 2. <u>Always use your car sign</u>, and keep it visible until you exit the property. If you need more car signs, let us know.
- 3. We will begin car circle when all required teachers are on the playground. Our goal is to start morning car circle by 9:00, and afternoon car circle by 1:00.
- 4. Pull up as far as you can when parking to make room for another car to park.
- 5. Pull up in car circle close to the car in front of you to allow as many cars as possible to fit in the driveway, keeping cars out of the road.
- 6. After your child is placed in your car, pull up as far as you can in the driveway to buckle up so that we can continue to load cars behind you.
- 7. Early drop off care is available at 8:30 for \$3.50/one morning ticket.
- 8. If you are struggling, please come to the office to speak to Tricia Wilson, Director, so that we can accommodate your needs.
- 9. Please be courteous of other drivers. Thank you!

ALWAYS HOLD YOUR CHILD'S HAND IN THE PARKING LOT

If you have more children than hands, we will assist you. This is our most important rule and the staff will remind you to follow it. We have never had a serious accident at drop off or dismissal time and want to avoid a potential tragedy.

POLICY REMINDERS

FDCF: There are several important policies that are now REQUIRED by the Florida Dept. of Children and Families, our licensing agency. They must be met without exception. These policies include:

- 1. Every child who enrolls **must have up to date immunization records and health exam forms** submitted **before** the child begins school.
- 2. Parents **must sign child in and out** every day. FDCF will not accept leniency in this matter.
- 3. You must return all other paperwork before your child can begin school.

Extended Day Options: Prepay for afternoon extended day for the semester is now available at a discounted rate for children attending 4 & 5 days. No tickets needed! It's not too late to sign up, this option starts September 3. **Bulk Tickets** are also available at a discounted rate and may be purchased in the office. If you purchase tickets whether in bulk or single books, **please remember to fill out and send your tickets in each day** so that we can arrange staffing for the afternoon, and you can avoid the upcharge when being billed for extended day without tickets or prepayment.

All children who are still here at 3:30 will be brought to the office and there will be a late charge of \$1.00 for each minute the child is here after 3:30. This late fee must be paid by Friday of the current week in order for your child to

continue to use Extended Day.

Our Tuition Policy: Please note that tuition invoices that are not paid

by the 7th of the month will be charged a \$35 late fee. If payment is not received in full by the end of the month, your child will be withdrawn from the program and your child's spot may be filled from the waiting list.
