## **Important Reminders**

#### Illness Policy

Children who show any of the symptoms listed on the WPPP Health Guidelines will be isolated and sent home from school and are to remain out of school for a full day following their dismissal. (Example: If a child is dismissed for illness on Monday, they cannot return until at least Wednesday morning, providing they are asymptomatic.) Parents picking up their sick child must sign out, and staff or administrative personnel will highlight the reason for dismissal so that other staffers will know the child should not be in attendance the following day.

Extended Day charges must be paid the day your child uses it, either with cash, check, or preferably a ticket(s). Ticket books can be purchased in the Preschool Office. We offer books of 5, 10, 12, or 25. Tickets are \$7.00 each. If you use Extended Day frequently, we offer a bulk ticket package (4 books of 25 @ \$6.00 per ticket).

Morning Extended Day is \$3.50 for anytime between 8:30 to 9:00am and may be paid with cash, check, or ticket. Morning Extended Day tickets are available in books of 25 and 10 tickets.

Anytime we have to charge your account for using Extended Day without tickets or payment, your account will be charged the rates of \$9.00 (until 2:30pm), \$18.00 (until 3:30pm) or \$4.50 (early drop off before 9:00am).
