



Summer Camp Registration Has Begun!

The preschool has many exciting activities planned for our Summer Camp 2017 program. The following is a sample of the curriculum planned:

Daily water activities: The children will enjoy water days, gardening, organized games and young scientist experiments such as making homemade exploding volcanoes, creating and printing fossils, growing salt crystals, designing spider webs, studying insects, designing a real bird feeder and making slime, goop and gorp.

Some of the art activities will include: Messy outside art, water color paint, air dry clay, recycle art, Incredible Foam Dough, Air Dry Putty creations, and collaborative collages. Every day water and outside activities: Kid wash, wading pools, sprinklers, water tables, exploration tables, mud and gook, gooey messy stuff, air drying clay, and many opportunities for construction & building.

Summer Camp Dates: June 12 to July 28, 2017

- ◆ Session 2 : June 26 through 30.
- ◆ Session 3: July 3 through 7
(closed July 4th).
- ◆ Session 4: July 10 through 14.
- ◆ Session 5: July 17 through 21.
- ◆ Session 6: July 24 through 28.

Camp hours are 9:00-1:00. Extended day is available from 8:30-9:00 and 1:00-3:30.

The cost for sessions 1, 2, 4, 5, 6 is \$150 for each session. The cost for session 3 is \$120.

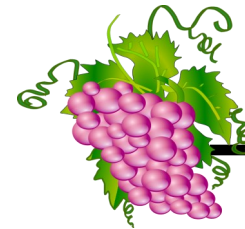
Non-refundable deposit is due for each session. Check flyer for deposit amounts. Discounts are not available for summer camp.

The preschool is very excited to announce plans in the works for a Nature Center. Our vision will come to reality on Saturday, March 4th when volunteers on our building team will begin constructing this center.

The Nature Center will be located across from the Pine Playground near the back door of the Art Room. There will be a 3 foot tall wooden picket fence enclosure with arbors at the two entrances.
