Summer Camp Registration Has Begun!



The preschool has many exciting activities planned for our Summer Camp 2018 program. The following is a sample of the curriculum planned:

Daily outside activities: The children will enjoy water days, gardening, organized games and young scientist experiments such as making homemade exploding volcanoes, creating and printing fossils, studying insects, designing a real bird feeder and making slime, goop and gorp.

Some of the art activities will include: Messy outside art, water color paint, air dry clay, recycle art, Incredible Foam Dough, Air Dry Putty creations, and collaborative collages.
