Campers experience the rich environment of the Arts Center throughout the week balancing each day with guided instruction, free exploration, computer lab research, cooking, gardening, science, stories, games and free recess. Campers will be exposed to real art making skills in our nationally recognized arts center and prepare for a mini exhibition for parents and other guests on the last day of their camp.

Session One: June 10-14 <u>CREATE-A-THON!</u>

Ready...Set...Draw, Paint, Sculpt, Print, CREATE! This camp is for the budding artist in all of us. Campers will make drawing journals, portfolios and develop a collection of art works in all media. Instruction focuses on foundation techniques with basic art materials and includes daily art appreciation.

THE ART OF NATURE

Create a small terrarium with special magic you create from kiln fired clay pieces. Build, paint, print and explore working with sticks, stones, flowers, leaves and more. This camp is all about connecting with the outdoors and bringing it into our artful creations.

Session Two: June 17-21 PAINT AND PRINT PALOOZA

Explore all kinds of paints and papers, canvas and screen print your tee shirt, print with nature, make sun prints, create your own paint pigments from flowers and foods.

Session Three: July 1, 2, 3 & 5 <u>IT CAME FROM OUTER SPACE!!!!</u>

Ever wonder what lives in outer space? We'll build the coolest spaceships, aliens and cosmic objects the universe has ever seen! Get ready to blast off in to clay and multi-media fun. Keep your creations and take them on future galactic adventures.

Session Four: July 15-19 CLAY CREATIONS

Enjoy hands on fun and learning about different kinds of clay. Explore hand building skills, prepare pieces for kiln firing and painting with underglazes and glaze. Create a self-portrait sculpture, animal story plaque and a kooky cookie jar.

Program Information:

Each session consists of one week Monday through Friday. Tuition for the one week is \$130.00 (This price includes materials). Session 3 (July 1-5) tuition is \$104.00 due to no camp July 4. A non-refundable deposit of \$65.00 per session toward the total tuition is due at the time of registration. Tuition is due the week before camp begins.

Catherine Cross will be the instructor for all summer art camps. She is the Arts Specialist at WPPP and has been an active arts instructor with the Orlando Museum of Art. Mrs. Cross is also a nationally recognized speaker on the topic of Early Childhood Art. She loves art and sharing her love of art with children and has been with our program for fifteen years. She has over 25 years of experience in the visual arts working with children and families.

Note: Catherine provides age appropriate art activities related to the theme for all students in the classroom that range in age from 3 to 12 depending on the class.
