

How to apply for your child's FL VPK Certificate of Eligibility

Florida's Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program, or VPK, is an educational program that includes age appropriate learning experiences with an emphasis on early literacy skills and kindergarten readiness. Providers receive a Readiness Rate based on results of assessments done in the classroom 2 or 3 times over the course of the school year. Winter Park Presbyterian Preschool's most recent Readiness Rate is 92 on a scale of 60-100.

Your child must meet the following criteria to be eligible for Florida's VPK program:

- 1. Reside in the state of Florida. Proof of residency is required by any one of: FL driver's license; water, electric, cable or home phone (not cell) bill; current lease or mortgage.
- 2. Be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2022 to register for the 2022-2023 school year program. Parents whose children are born between February 2 and September 1 of the calendar year may postpone enrolling their 4-year-old until the following year when their child is 5.



To register your child for VPK, simply visit the Family Portal at: https://familyservices.floridaearlylearning.com/ (or scan QR code on the left) where you will create an account and complete the application process.

Winter Park Presbyterian Preschool offers VPK and VPK Plus programs. Both options require a VPK Certificate of Eligibility to receive reimbursement funding from the state of Florida. A VPK certificate is required to register for the 2022-2023 WPPP VPK program.
